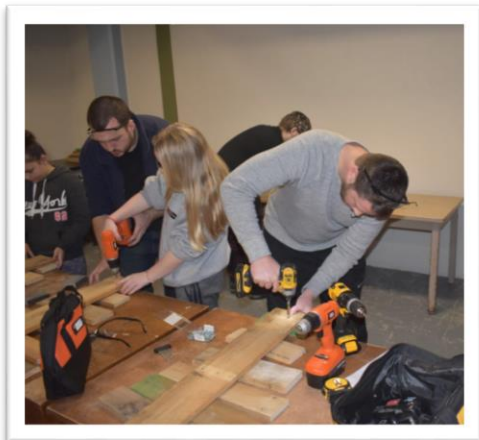
Every child in Leeds and Grenville who needs a mentor, has a mentor.
