



MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



2023 IN REVIEW







Our core one-to-one mentoring provides lifelong, positive impact, protecting youth from the harm of adverse childhood experiences. This year we have supported 29 Community-Based matches and 22 In-School matches.

COMMUNITY BASED GROUP - 81

This year we have various group programs available to youth including Teen Drop-In at the Brockville Public Library, March Break Camp, PRISM, Summer Family Fun Fridays, Monthly Jr. Youth Nights at the Kemptville Youth Centre.

SITE BASED GROUP - 195

We partnered with local schools to deliver "Safe Spaces" our group programming to youth. The program was designed to foster attitudes of positive motivation, increased self-awareness and self-confidence as well as feelings of safety, belonging and worth.


My Little Sister gives me the opportunity to see the world through a child's eyes again. She pushes me to do things I wouldn't normally do as an adult - like jumping in the pool instead of wading in, or breaking out into song and dance with her. We talk about things going on in her life, and I know she sees me as a safe person. What I enjoy most about our time together is that it's meant to be fun. We have serious talks sometimes, but we also play a lot of tag and hide and seek. I don't have to try and be her teacher/counsellor/parent, my job is to just have fun with her, while being a positive role model.

I've been curious about the Big Brothers Big Sisters program for quite some time, and finally decided to go for it this spring. I couldn't be happier with my decision! The team at BBBSLG is incredibly supportive, and they even provide us with a calendar of free/low-cost events and some activity supplies every month.

This program is life changing not only for the Littles, but for the Bigs as well!
